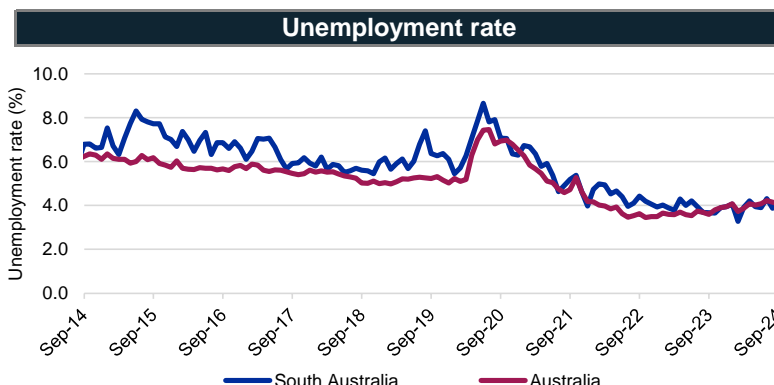

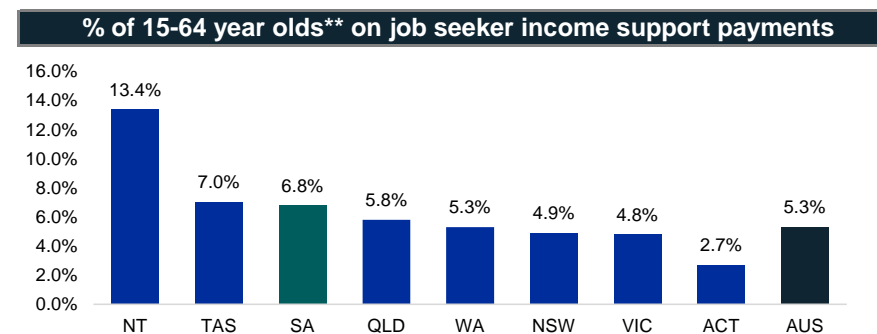

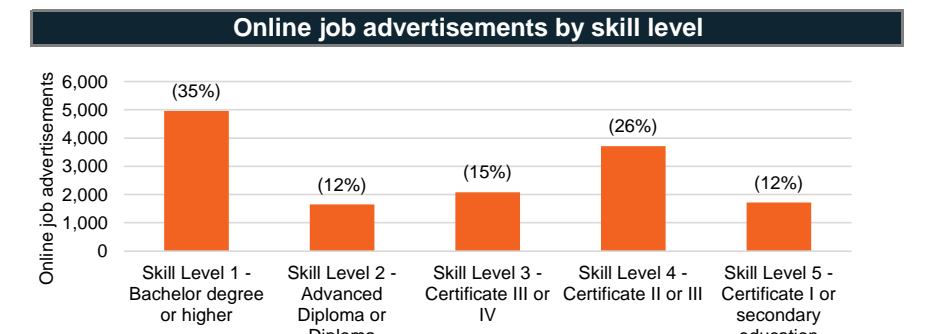

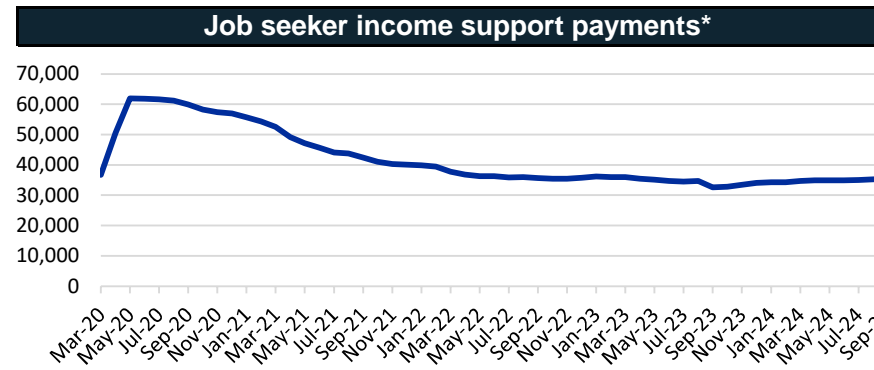

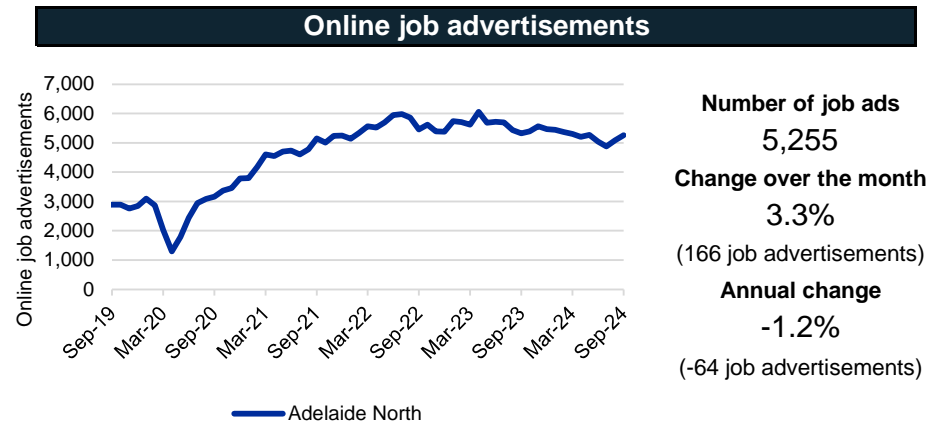

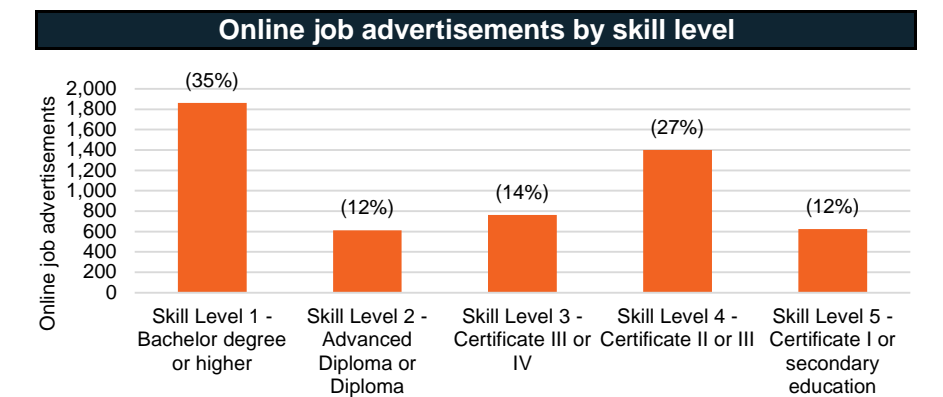

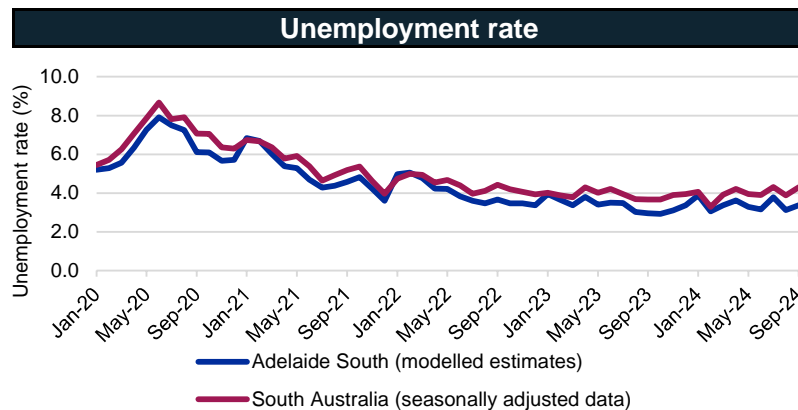

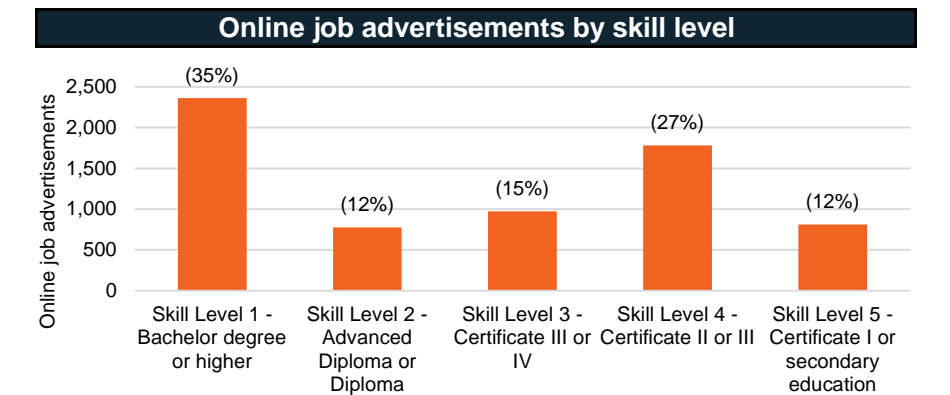

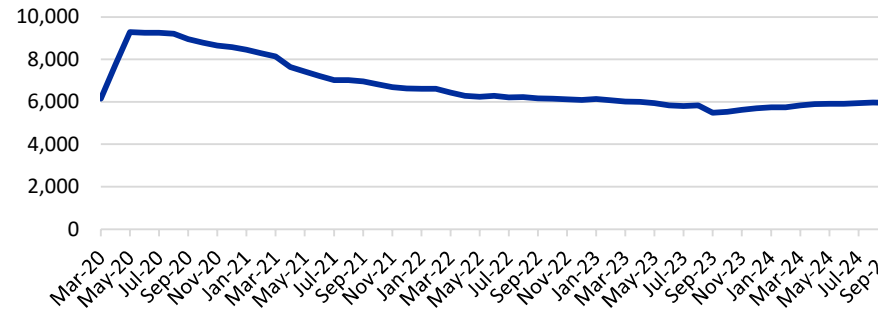

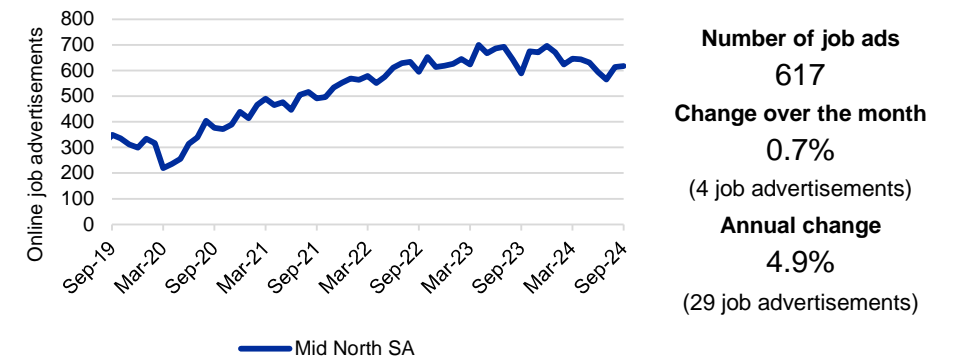

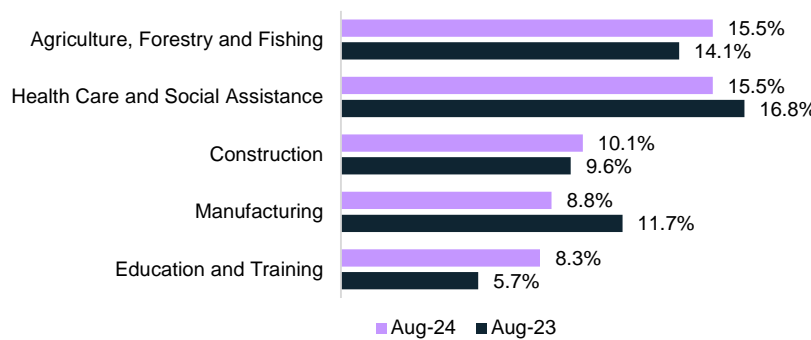

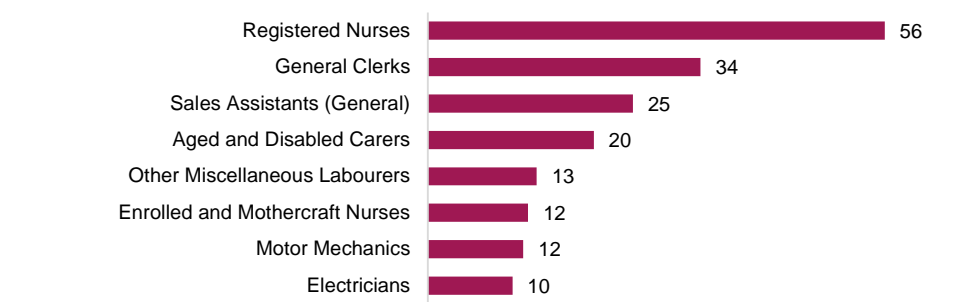

**Largest employing industries**



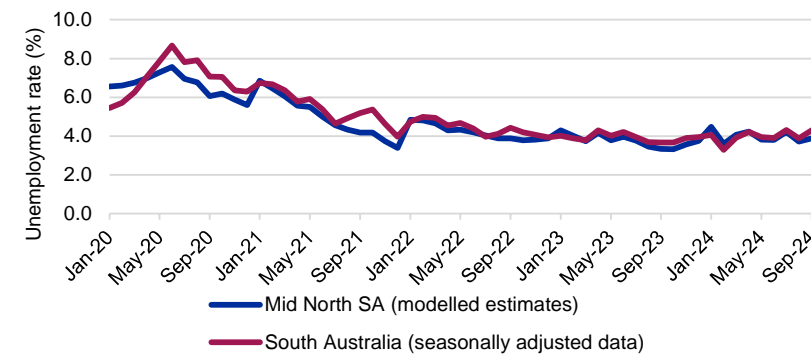

**Online job advertisements by occupation**



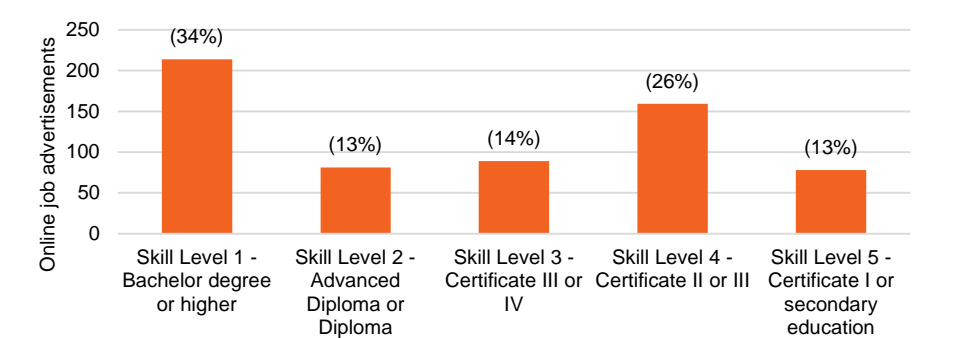

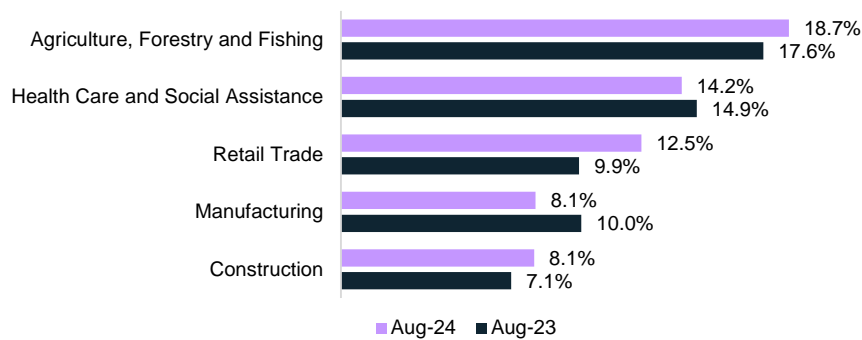

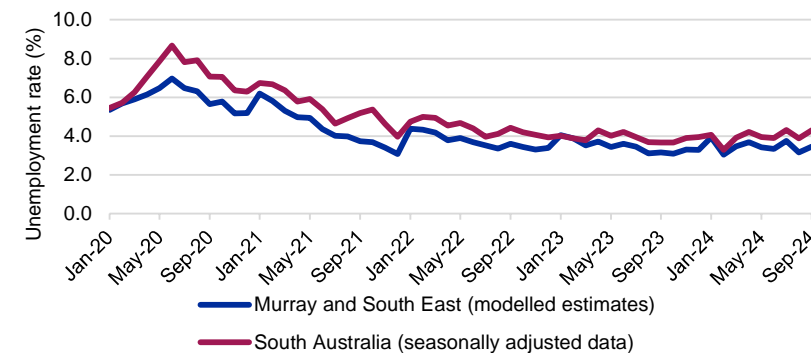

**Largest employing industries**



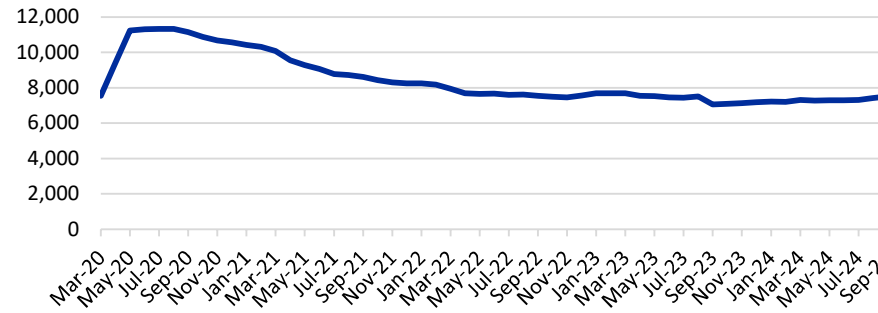

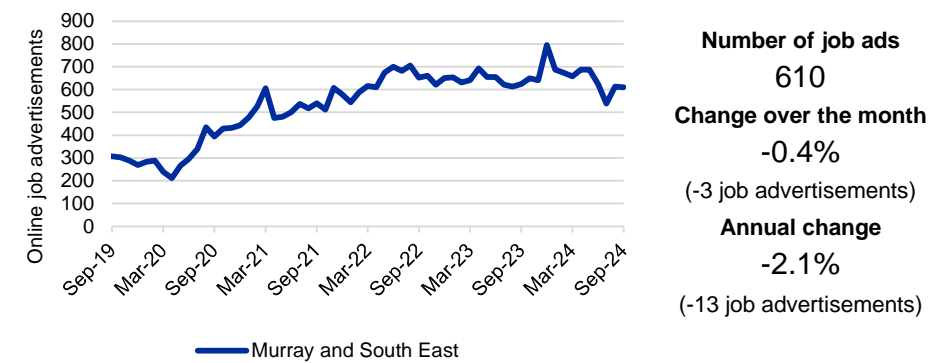

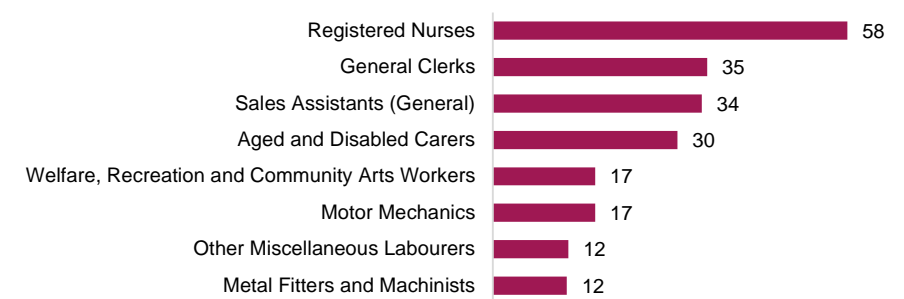

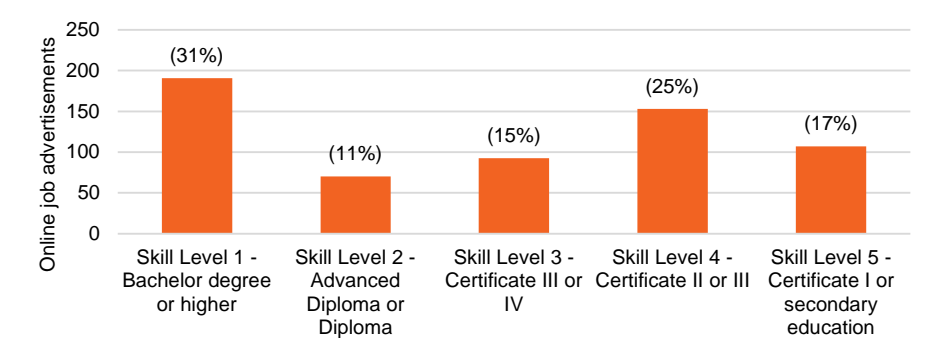
